You must be willing to surrender your own ideas. Samson was willing to pay the price to get the power of God again! He was in dead earnest. You fathers, you mothers, are you ready to establish an altar in your house, and take that television out? Are you ready to take that deck of cards off the table? Them comic books that your children's reading, preparing their little mind for a blast that the Devil's going to give them? Are you willing to cry out "Once more Lord!" When we ought to be in the promised land, we're still wandering around in the wilderness. Let me say this my friend, you better destroy your enemy before your enemy destroys you. Bring back the old-fashioned prayer meeting. Old fashioned repentance, when they stayed to the altar until they was dead and finished with sin." -

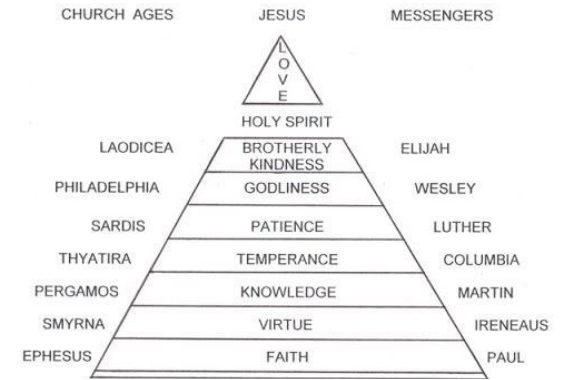
